## Details of Payment Options

### FEE-HELP

Domestic students that meet the requirements outlined in the FEE-HELP information booklet may choose to defer their Tuition Fees through the Commonwealth Government FEE-HELP loan scheme. Fees are processed on the Census Date of each semester based on the unit of study price for that semester. If you are interested in applying for FEE-HELP, please complete the 'Application for FEE-HELP Assistance' included in your enrolment pack, and submit this to Southbank Institute with your enrolment forms.

### Payment in Full

Unless processed through the FEE-HELP scheme or Southbank Institute Payment Plan, Tuition Fees can be paid at any time leading up to the Census Date. These Tuition Fees must be paid in full by Census Date.

### Institute Payment Plan

Domestic students may apply to Southbank Institute for a 3 month Payment Plan. Payment Plans are required to be paid in 3 x 1 monthly instalments commencing at the beginning of each semester, with the first payment due at the time of enrolment. Applicants who elect to pay fees up front or via an agreed Southbank Institute Payment Plan can make payment/s using one of the following methods:
